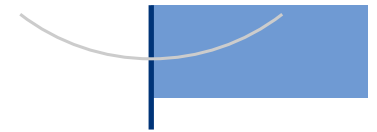

Chairman's Challenge

for Williamsburg's Fourth Century

In anticipation of the Williamsburg Community Foundation's 10th anniversary, you can join the celebration by establishing a \$5,000 named unrestricted endowment with a contribution of \$2,500.

Former chairman John Jamison has provided the resources to help endow the future of Williamsburg. The challenge gives you a great opportunity to make an enduring gift to the community by setting up a named component of the Community Endowment. This is a source of funds for grants to local nonprofit organizations that serve our area.

A recent recipient is **Flute Frenzy**. A WCF trustee attended the group's performance. Impressed with the players' enthusiasm and musical skills, he remarked, *The Foundation's \$1,000 grant seems to have had a \$1 million impact on the lives of these young artists.* Accept the Chairman's Challenge and make a difference.

The Foundation's goal is to celebrate its 10th anniversary in 2009 by reaching \$1 million in the Community Endowment. At this level it will provide \$35,000 each year for distribution to the community.

How does the match work?

- You make a gift or pledge to establish a new named unrestricted fund at the Foundation.
- You become a founding member of the Foundation's Community Endowment.
- The pledge period can be between one and five years, with the final payment due in 2011.
- For a gift in the range between \$2,500 and \$5,000 the Chairman's Challenge will add an additional \$2,500 to your fund.
- For any gift over \$5,000, it will add \$1 to your fund for each \$2 that you give.
- Maximum gift eligible for the match is \$25,000. Minimum is \$2,500. (See chart of match examples on the back.)

Act now!

- Over half of the challenge funding has been claimed by generous local donors.
- The Foundation accepts cash, stock or real property. If you have questions about a particular type of gift, call the foundation office at 757-259-1660 .

The fine print

- The fund must be an endowed, unrestricted fund.
- Funds can be established with a transfer from your existing donor-advised fund.
- Funds established prior to this challenge are not eligible for the match.
